SPCA Fiji Islands is in the process of reinventing itself. An all new, dynamic and committed committee is steering the 65 year old organisation into the future. We need you to help us get there. The SPCA is the only animal shelter in Fiji's capital city of Suva and in the whole Southern half of the main island of Viti Levu. We are a small but busy, not for profit animal shelter and clinic. The shelter temporarily houses strays and surrenders for rehoming, while our clinic aims to both support the shelter and provide affordable services to local clients.

We are urgently in need of qualified people prepared to assist us with intensive spay and neuter Clinics. In Suva alone we have a waiting list of over 500 people wanting to have their pets de-sexed. We are aiming to coordinate teams of volunteers to conduct these Outreach Clinics in the more remote communities and islands of Fiji.
